***IMPORTANT NOTE: Testing is in the spring of each school year. WVGSA is administered to grades 3 through 11. Students must be registered by December 31st to participate. Due to the design of the assessment, students may be involved in testing for as many as 5 days.

Students must be assessed annually and the parents are to maintain copies of student's Academic Assessment for at least three years.

Assessments for grades 3, 5, 8 & 11 must be submitted to the Superintendent by June 30th of the year in which the assessment was administered.

This notice shall be in effect until I notify the county superintendent of termination of home instruction or my child/children reach compulsory school attendance age. Should I establish residence in a new county, I shall notify Monongalia County Schools in writing and submit a new Notice of Intent to the superintendent in the county in which I will reside.
