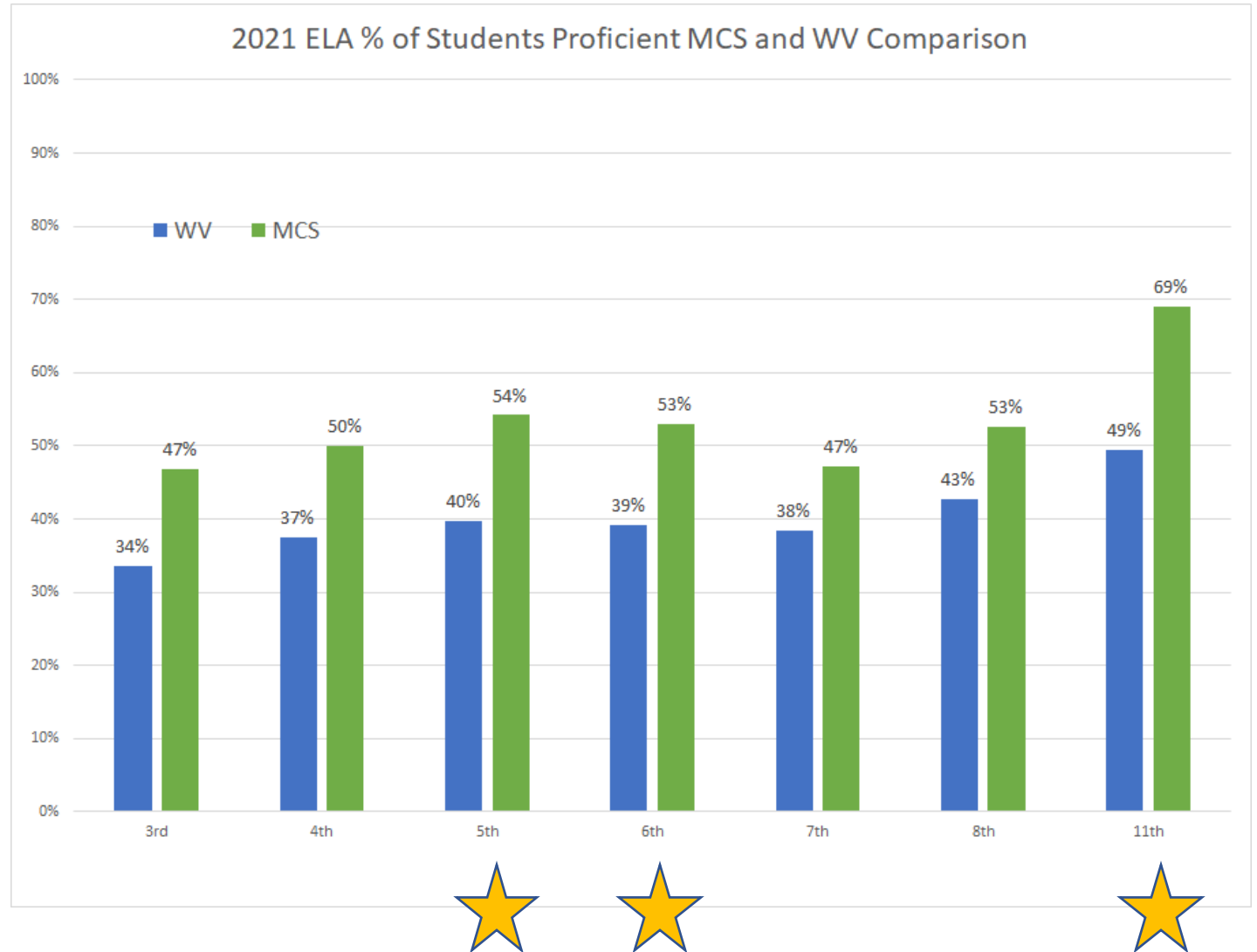

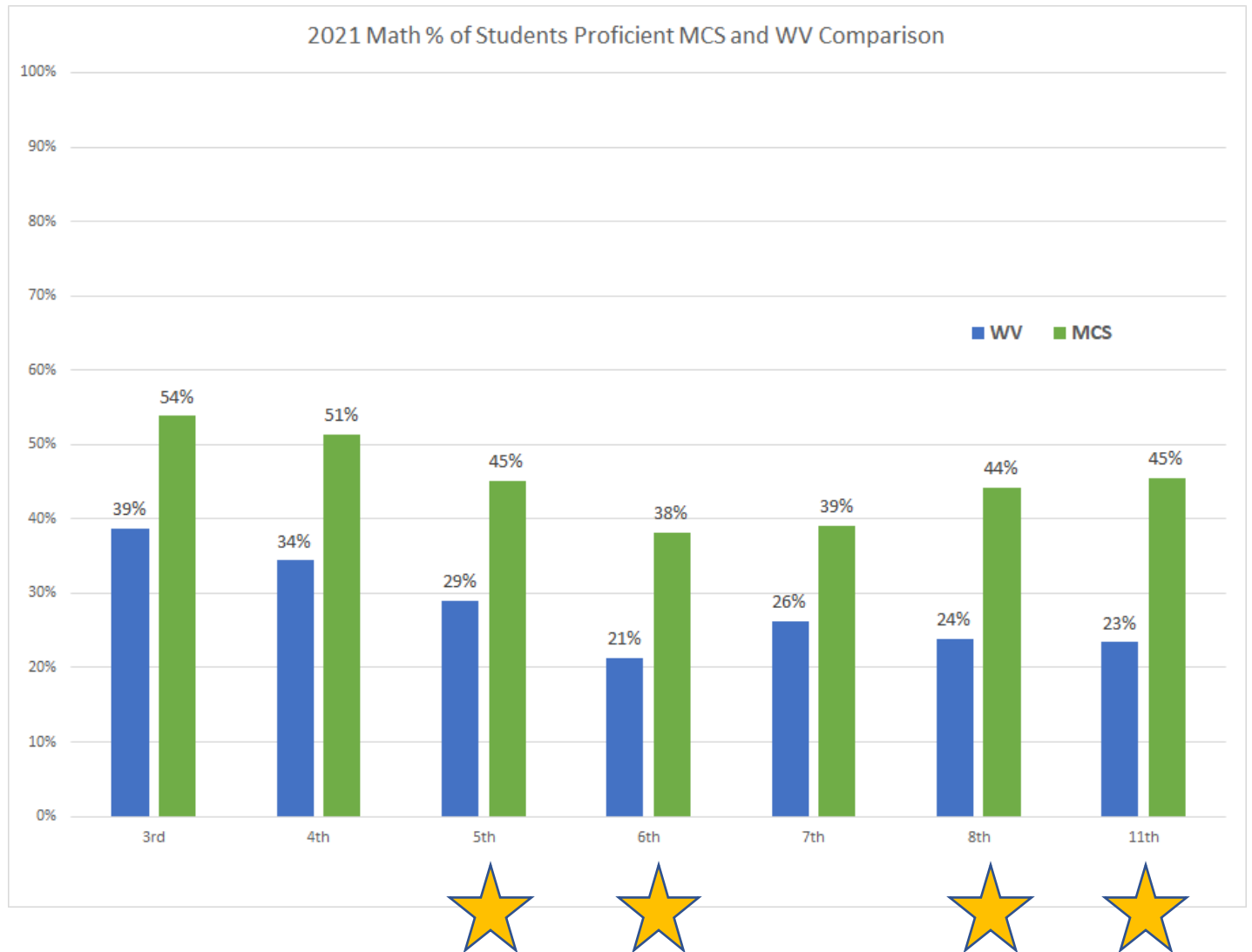

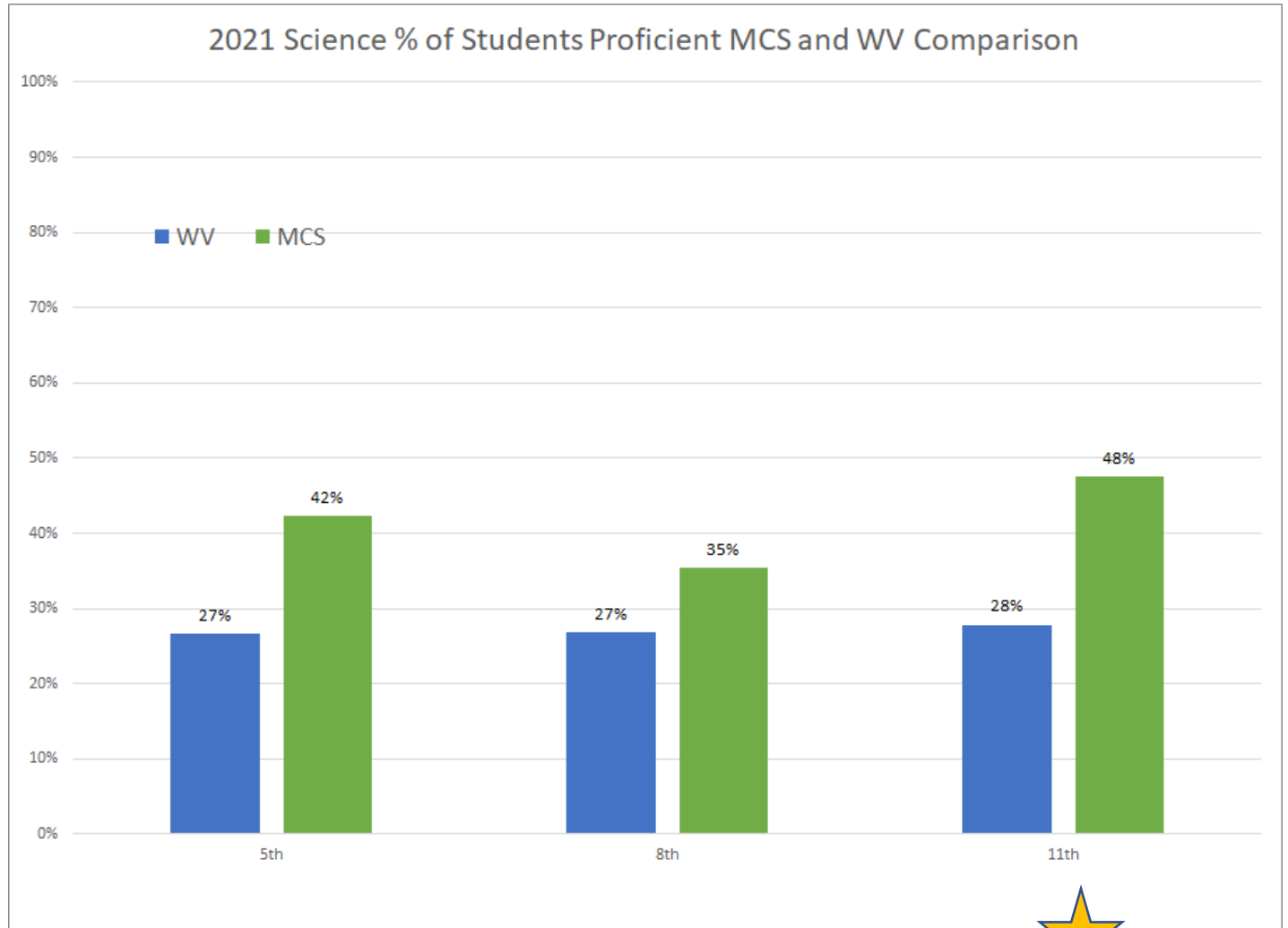
# Reading Proficiency



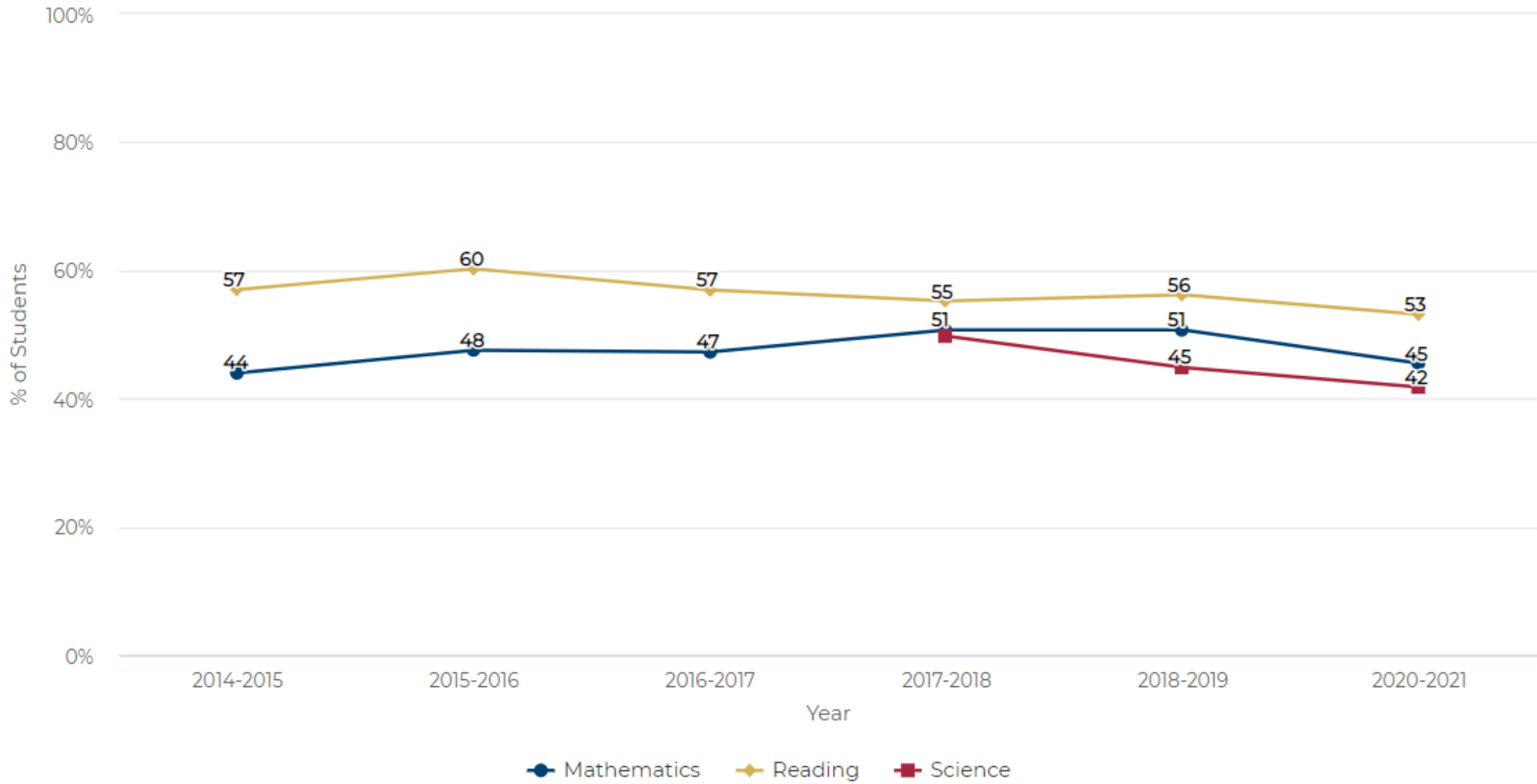
# Math Proficiency

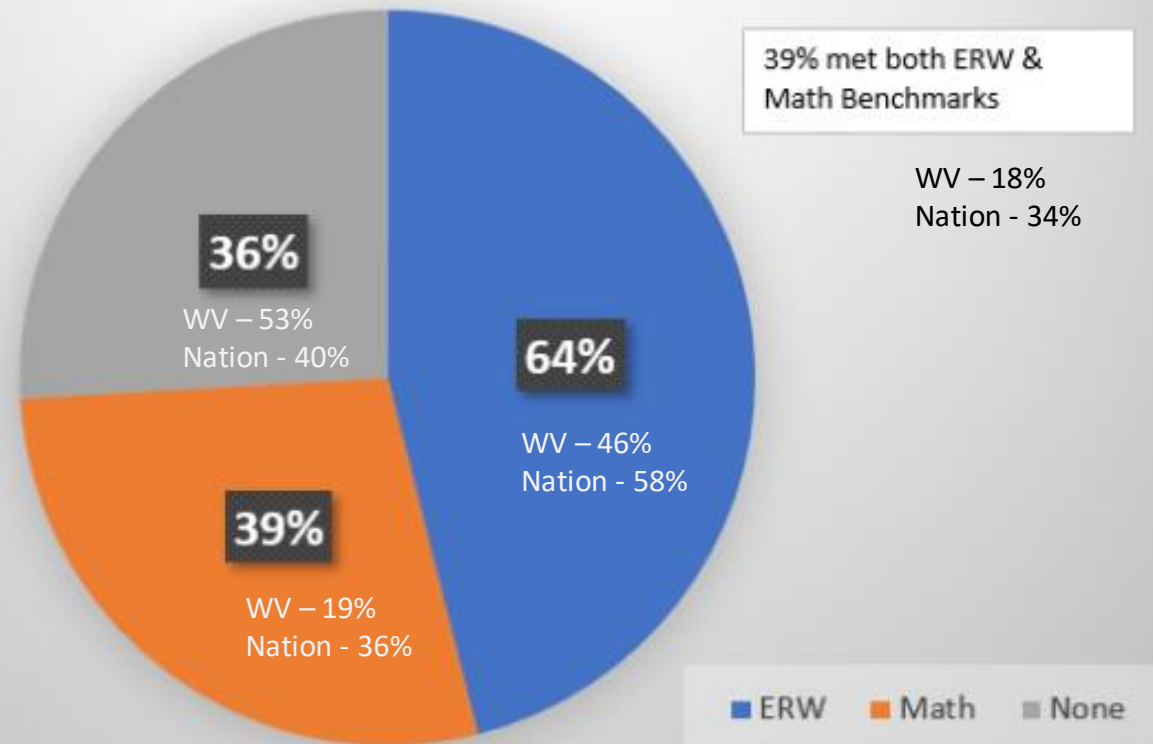

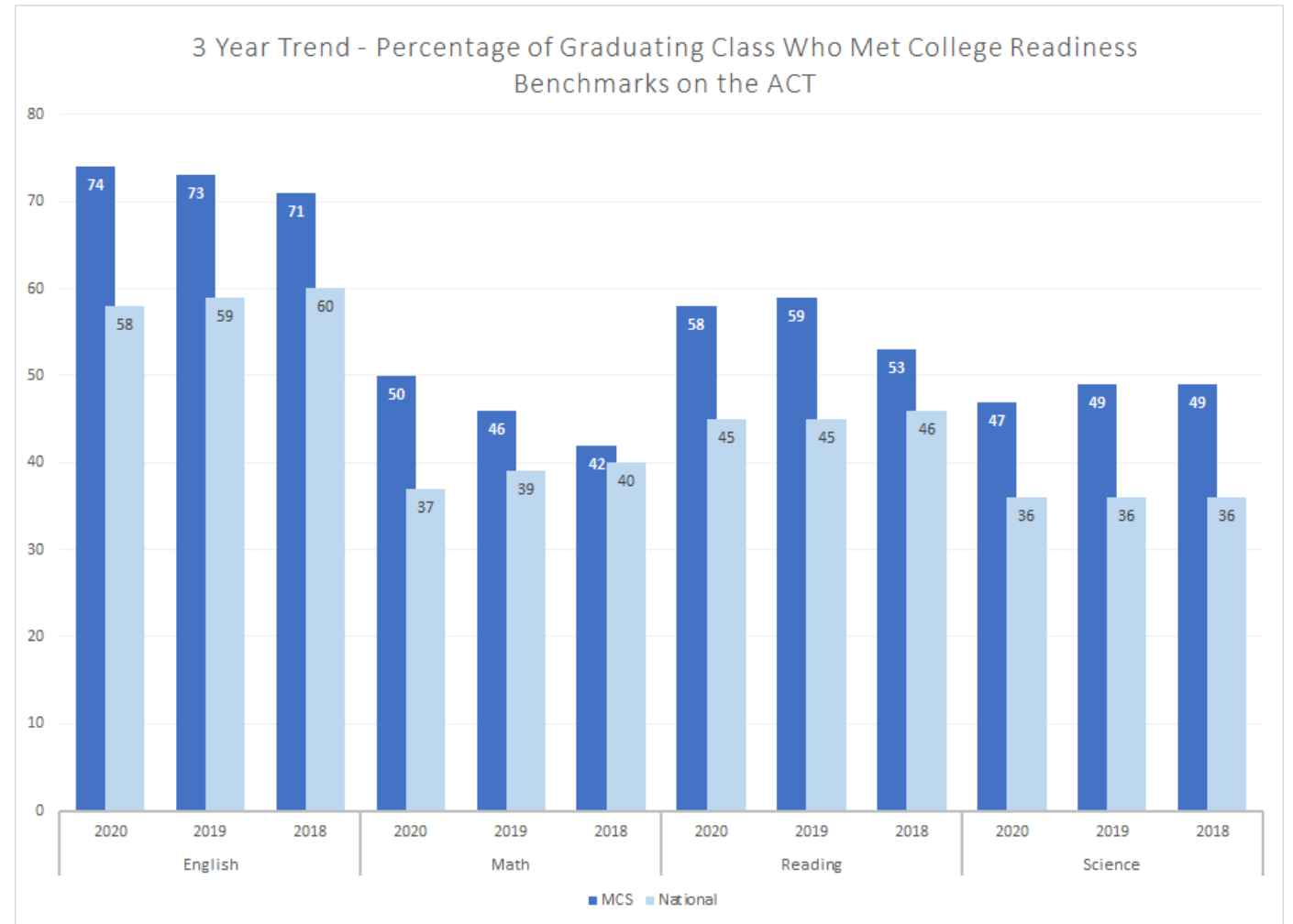

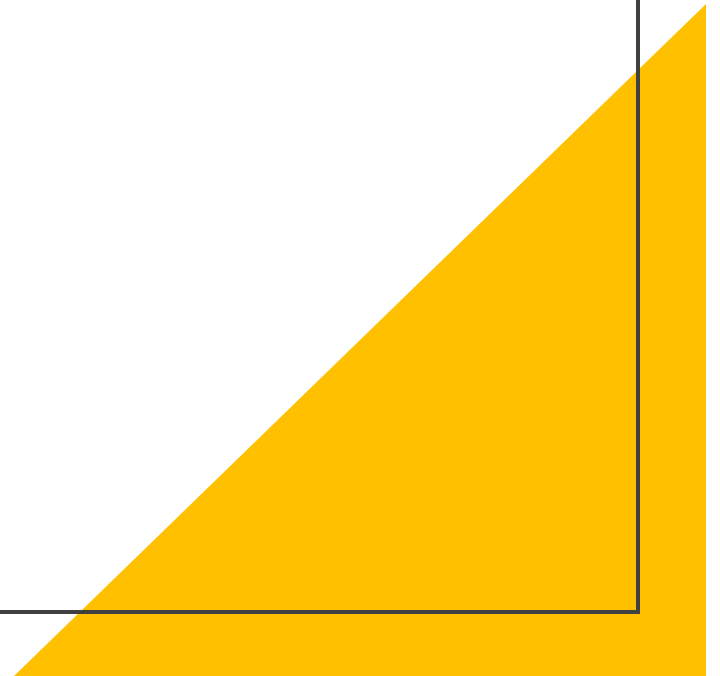
- Percentage of students meeting College Readiness Benchmark Scores in 2021:

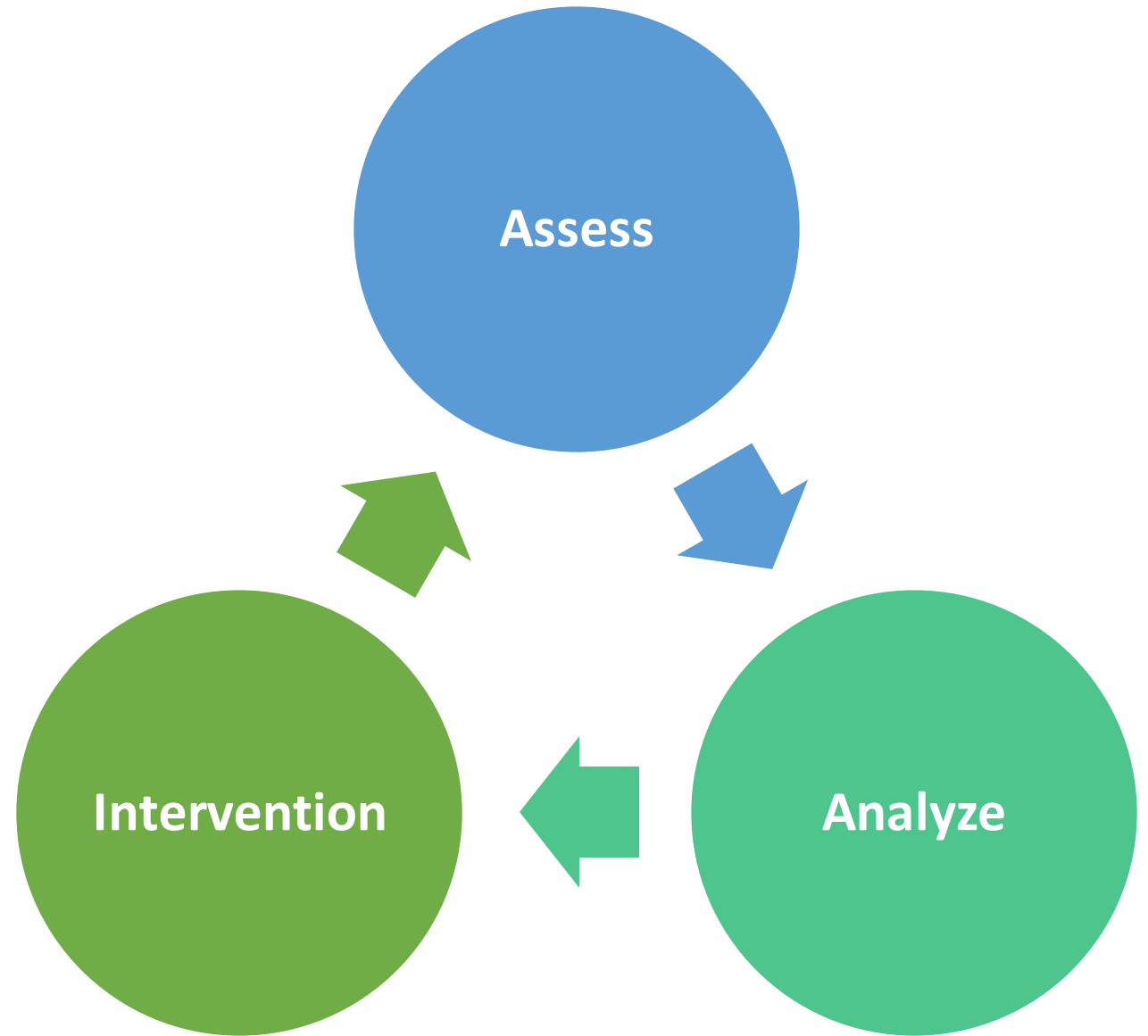


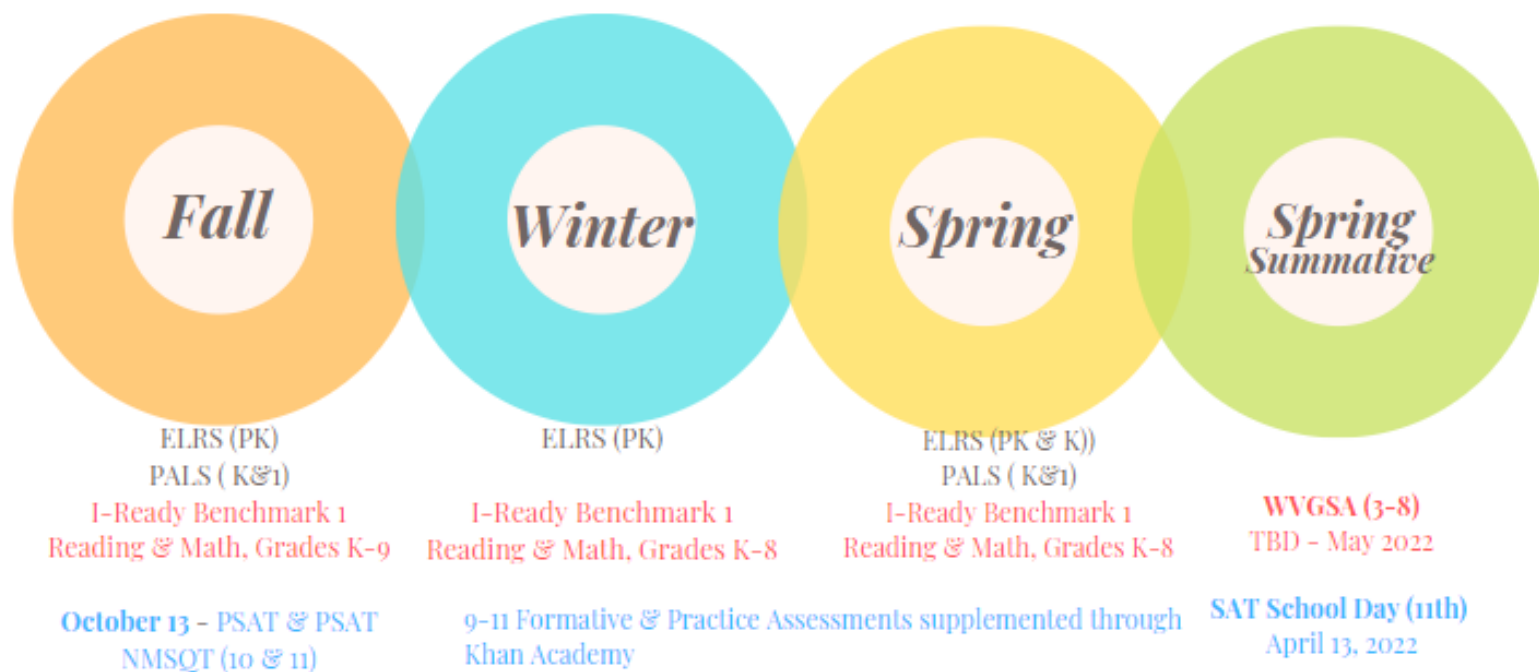
